**I, THEODOR MERON**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

**NOTING** the “Ordonnance du Président relative à l’attribution d’une affaire à une chambre de première instance,” filed on 15 May 2002, assigning the case of *Prosecutor v. Fatmir Limaj, Haradin Bala, Isak Musliu, and Agim Murtezi*, IT-03-66, to Trial Chamber I, composed of Judges Liu, El Mahdi, and Orie;

**NOTING** the “Order of the President Assigning a Case to a Trial Chamber,” filed on 28 November 2002, assigning the case of *Prosecutor v. Momčilo Krajišnik*, IT-00-39, to Trial Chamber I, composed of Judges Liu, El Mahdi, and Orie;

**NOTING** the “Order Assigning Ad Litem Judge to a Case Before a Trial Chamber,” filed on 8 May 2003, in which I assigned Judge Joaquín Martín Canivell to Trial Chamber I for the case of *Prosecutor v. Momčilo Krajišnik*, IT-00-39;

**CONSIDERING** Security Council Resolution 1481 (2003), adopted on 19 May 2003, which amended Article 13 *quater* of the Statute of the International Tribunal to permit ad litem Judges to adjudicate in pre-trial proceedings;

**CONSIDERING** Rule 62 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, which requires the President to assign cases to Trial Chambers, and Rule 19(A), which authorizes the President to coordinate the work of the Chambers;

**HEREBY ORDER** that, for the case of *Prosecutor v. Fatmir Limaj, Haradin Bala, Isak Musliu, and Agim Murtezi*, IT-03-66, Trial Chamber I shall be composed, with immediate effect, as follows:


