

PURSUANT TO RULE 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal,

HEREBY ORDERS that the adjournment of trial proceedings in Case No. IT-02-60-T continues until 7 July 2003, upon which time the Prosecution shall continue with its presentation of evidence.
