I, MEHMET GÜNEY, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING that the Appeals Chamber is seised of notices of appeal filed by Milorad Krnojelac on 12 April 2002 and by the Prosecution on 15 April 2002, from the Judgement of Trial Chamber II, dated 15 March 2002, in the case of *Prosecutor v. Milorad Krnojelac*;

NOTING that sub-Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) requires “the Appeals Chamber or an Appeals Chamber Judge” to “convene a status conference, within one hundred and twenty days of the filing of a notice of appeal and thereafter within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person”;

NOTING FURTHER the “Order replacing Pre-Appeal Judge”, issued on 18 March 2003, which appoints Judge Mehmet Güney to replace Judge Theodor Meron as Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

CONSIDERING that Milorad Krnojelac is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending the delivery of the Judgement on appeal;


CONSIDERING that the last Status Conference in this case was held on 3 April 2003 and that the next Status Conference is due to be held no later than 3 July 2003;

HAVING consulted the parties;

PURSUANT to sub-Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules;

ORDER that a Status Conference shall be held before me on Friday 4 July 2003 at 2.30 p.m.
