**TRIAL CHAMBER II** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

**NOTING** the Scheduling Order issued on 17 June 2003, which scheduled a hearing and a status conference, pursuant to Rule 65 *ter* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal ("Rules"), on 24 and 26 June 2003 respectively ("Scheduling Order of 17 June"),

**CONSIDERING** that the Defence has indicated that they waive the right that a status conference be held within one hundred and twenty days of the previous status conference, and that the Prosecution also indicated their agreement,


**CONSIDERING** that it would be appropriate to hold a status conference before the summer recess, and that such a conference may tentatively be scheduled on Monday 28 July 2003,
