TRIAL CHAMBER II of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for

Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former

Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

NOTING the Scheduling Order issued on 17 June 2003, which scheduled a hearing and a status

conference, pursuant to Rule 65 ter of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal

("Rules"), on 24 and 26 June 2003 respectively ("Scheduling Order of 17 June"),

CONSIDERING that the Defence has indicated that they waive the right that a status conference

be held within one hundred and twenty days of the previous status conference, and that the

Prosecution also indicated their agreement,

**CONSIDERING** that it would be appropriate to hold a status conference before the summer recess,

and that such a conference may tentatively be scheduled on Monday 28 July 2003,

PURSUANT TO Rules 65 bis and 65 ter of the Rules,
