**TRIAL CHAMBER I** (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

**NOTING** the arrest of the accused Ivica Rajić in Croatia on 5 April 2003 and his transfer to the seat of the Tribunal on 24 June 2003,

**PURSUANT** to Rule 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,


**HEREBY ORDERS** the detention on remand of Ivica Rajić,

**INSTRUCTS** the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the accused until further order and,

**CONFIRMS** that 24 June 2003 shall be the date from which for any purposes it shall be recorded that the Accused has been in the custody of the Tribunal.
