**THIS BENCH** of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

**BEING SEIZED OF** “General Ojdanić’s Appeal from Decision on Motion Challenging Jurisdiction and Motion for Extension of Time to File Opening Brief”, filed by the Appellant Dragoljub Ojdanić on 13 May 2003 (“Appeal and Motion for Extension of Time”);

**RECALLING** the Order issued by this Bench on 19 May 2003, whereby proceedings in the present interlocutory appeal were suspended until the relevant Trial Chamber issued its decision on the Appellant’s motion requesting additional funds for his Defence (“Motion for Additional Funds”) and the Bench also indicated that it would issue its decision on the Appeal and Motion for Extension of Time in light of the Trial Chamber’s decision;


**NOTING** that, on 8 July 2003, the Trial Chamber issued a decision denying the Motion for Additional Funds;

**NOTING** “General Ojdanić’s Request for Certification to Appeal *Decision on Motion for Additional Funds*”, filed by the Appellant before the Trial Chamber on 14 July 2003 (“Request”);

**CONSIDERING** that the Appellant’s Counsel have already indicated in the Appeal and Motion for Extension of Time that they are not able to deal with this appeal on a *pro bono* basis;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that the proceedings in this appeal remain suspended until further order from the Bench.
