TRIAL CHAMBER I, SECTION A, ("Trial Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law

Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED OF the "Request for Extension of Time to File Request for Certification (Rule

73)" ("Request"), filed on behalf of Accused, Vidoje Blagojević, on 16 July 2003, by the

Independent Counsel assigned to him by the Registrar, on a confidential and ex parte basis, in

which it is requested that an eight-day extension of time be granted to file a request for certification,

NOTING the Trial Chamber's decision of 3 July 2003, 2 in which it denied the Accused's motion to

replace his lead counsel and co-counsel,3

NOTING that a B/C/S translation of the Trial Chamber's Decision was delivered to the Accused on

10 July 2003, and that a B/C/S translation of the Registrar's response to the Accused's Motion was

delivered to the Accused on 16 July 2003,

RECALLING that the Trial Chamber orally ruled that the seven-day time period for requesting

certification began to run on the date that the Accused received the Trial Chamber's Decision in

B/C/S,4

NOTING that that a B/C/S translation of the Accused's lead counsel and co-counsel's response to

his Motion has not been completed and it is anticipated that this translation will be completed by 23

July 2003,

CONSIDERING that, in the view of the Trial Chamber, it is important that the Accused be able to

consider the Trial Chamber's Decision as well as the submissions of both the Registrar and his

counsel in a language that he understands before deciding on whether to seek certification for leave

to appeal the Trial Chamber's Decision, pursuant to Rule 73 of the Rules of Procedure and
