**THIRD DECISION ON PROSECUTION'S MOTION FOR
LEAVE TO SUPPLEMENT EXHIBIT LIST**

TRIAL CHAMBER I, SECTION A, ("Trial Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED OF the "Prosecution's Motion for Leave to Supplement Exhibit List," filed under seal on 3 July 2003 ("Motion"), in which the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") seeks to add to its exhibit list documents obtained by its office in May and June 2003,

NOTING that neither of the Accused filed a response to the Motion,

NOTING that one category of documents which the Prosecution seeks to add to its exhibit list was obtained by the Prosecution during the course of discussions with Dragan Obrenović in late May 2003, and was disclosed to the Accused and their defence counsel ("Defence") on 6 June 2003,

NOTING that the second category of documents was obtained by the Prosecution during the course of discussions with a third person on 10 June 2003, and was disclosed to the Accused and the Defence on 17 June 2003,

NOTING that the translation of all documents and other materials into English is on-going,


CONSIDERING that the Prosecution submits that these documents and other materials are "extremely relevant to the Prosecution's case,"

CONSIDERING that all documents were disclosed to the Accused and the Defence in a timely fashion, and that the Defence has sufficient time to review the materials obtained from Dragan Obrenović before he will be called to testify in this case,

PURSUANT TO Rule 73 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal,

HEREBY GRANTS the Motion and further **ORDERS** that an updated list of exhibits be filed forthwith.
