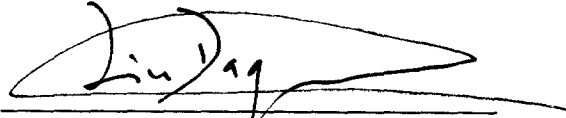
CONSIDERING Rule 65 *ter* (M) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”);
