I, **MOHAMED SHAHABUDEEN**, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the International Tribunal”),

NOTING that the Appeals Chamber is seised of a notice of appeal filed by Mitar VASILJEVIĆ on 30 December 2002 from the Judgement of Trial Chamber II, dated 29 November 2002, in the case of *Prosecutor v. Mitar VASILJEVIĆ*;

NOTING that sub-Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“the Rules”) requires “[t]he Appeals Chamber or an Appeals Chamber Judge” to “convene a status conference, within one hundred and twenty days of the filing of a notice of appeal and thereafter within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person”;

CONSIDERING that Mitar VASILJEVIĆ is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending the hearing of the appeal;


CONSIDERING that the last status conference in this case was held on 28 April 2003;
