I, AMIN EL MAHDI, Judge in Trial Chamber I ("the Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("the Tribunal");

NOTING the decision of 3rd December 2001 of the Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber I to appoint me as the Pre-Trial Judge in the case *The Prosecutor v. Paško Ljubičić* (the "Accused");

NOTING that the last Status Conference under Rule 65bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules") was held on 23th May 2003;


NOTING that Rule 65bis of the Rules requires the Pre-Trial Judge to convene a status conference within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference to organize the exchanges between the parties so as to ensure expeditious preparation for trial, to review the status of the case and to allow the accused an opportunity to raise issues in relation in particular to his mental or physical conditions;

PURSUANT to Rules 54, 65bis and 65ter of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDERS that a Status Conference be held on Thursday 25 September 2003 at 15:00 hours in Courtroom III in the presence of the Accused and that the Parties be ready to discuss the status of the case and its final preparation for trial.
