TRIAL CHAMBER I, (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the Tribunal”);

NOTING finding of guilt against Ranko Češić by the Trial Chamber on 8th October 2003;

NOTING that, pursuant to Rule 100 of the Rules and Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (the “Rules”), the Prosecution and Ranko Češić may now submit any relevant information that may assist the Trial Chamber in determining an appropriate sentence, and that a date is to be fixed for the sentencing hearing;


PURSUANT TO Rule 100 of the Rules;
