I, LIU DAQUN, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for

Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former

Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal") and pre-trial Judge in these proceedings,

NOTING that the initial appearance of the accused Ivica Rajić took place on 27 June 2003,

CONSIDERING that pursuant to Rule 65 bis (A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence

("Rules") a Status Conference shall be convened within one hundred and twenty days of the initial

appearance of the accused in order to ensure expeditious preparation for trial and to allow the
