TRIAL CHAMBER I, (the “Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the Tribunal”);

NOTING the “*Order confirming assignment of a Case to a Trial Chamber*” of the Acting President Judge Fausto Pocar, filed on 23rd October 2003, assigning this case of *Prosecutor v Vladimir Kovačević* to Trial Chamber I;

NOTING that the Accused was arrested on 25th September 2003 and transferred to The Hague on 23rd October 2003;

NOTING that under Rule 62 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the “Rules”) the Accused shall be brought before the Trial Chamber or Judge without delay, and shall be formally charged;


NOTING the Experts’ Report dated 16th October commissioned by the Belgrade District Court dated 16th October; the Report of the District Prison Physician in Belgrade dated 22nd October 2003; and further noting the oral report from the staff of the United Nations Detention Unit of 27th October;

CONSIDERING that due to the medical condition of the Accused as set out in the above reports the initial appearance is delayed;

HEREBY SCHEDULES an initial appearance of Vladimir Kovačević for Monday 3rd November 2003 at 3.00 pm.
