THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

Proprio motu

NOTING the list of exhibits filed pursuant to Rule 65 ter by the Prosecution,

NOTING the Order of the Trial Chamber requiring the Prosecution to finalise its witness list, filed on 30 September 2003,

CONSIDERING that after 264 days of hearing and 20 months of trial, and after hearing 265 witnesses, the Prosecution has still not produced a definitive exhibit list stating what the exhibits are it intends to rely on in its case,

PURSUANT to Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- The Prosecution shall produce, within 21 days, a definitive exhibit list, setting out the documents it intends to introduce into evidence for the remainder of the Prosecution case;
- (2) The list may include confidential and/or ex parte schedules in order to protect witnesses; and
- (3) Any exhibit not listed in a definitive or unqualified manner will be excluded by the Chamber, unless it could not have been discovered in the exercise of due diligence by the Prosecution.
