**TRIAL CHAMBER I Section B** ("the Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("the Tribunal");

**NOTING** that the trial process was completed in this case in May 2003 and the Chamber began then its deliberation;

**NOTING** that Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules of procedure and evidence ("the Rules") requires the Chamber or a permanent Trial Chamber Judge to convene a status conference within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference;

**CONSIDERING** that it is appropriate in particular to allow the accused an opportunity to raise issues in relation to his mental or physical conditions;

**PURSUANT** to Rules 54 and 65 bis of the Rules;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that a Status Conference be held on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> November at 14:15 hours in Courtroom III in the presence of the Accused.
