TRIAL CHAMBER I, SECTION A ("Trial Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

NOTING the conviction entered against Dragan Obrenović by the Trial Chamber on 21 May 2003, based on his plea of guilty to Count 5 of the Amended Joinder Indictment dated 27 May 2002, namely, Persecutions, a Crime Against Humanity punishable under Article 5(h) of the Statute of the Tribunal,

NOTING that the Parties filed their Sentencing Briefs on 30 July 2003, and, following the testimony of Dragan Obrenović in the case *Prosecutor v. Vidoje Blagojević and Dragan Jokić* (Case No. IT-02-60-T), filed additional submissions to their Sentencing Briefs on 23 October 2003,

NOTING that a sentencing hearing was held in this case on 30 October 2003, during which the Trial Chamber heard the final submissions of the Parties,

PURSUANT TO Rule 100 (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal,

HEREBY ORDERS that a hearing at which the Sentencing Judgement will be delivered shall take place on 10 December 2003, commencing at 15:00 in Court Room 1.
