TRIAL CHAMBER II (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”):

HEREBY ORDERS:


1. A hearing is scheduled for 23 January 2004 commencing at 2.15 p.m.;
