**I, LIU DAQUN**, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) and pre-trial Judge in these proceedings,

**NOTING** the Trial Chamber’s Order Concerning the Prosecutor’s Motion Seeking Leave to Amend the Indictment, issued on 12 January 2004, in which the Trial Chamber granted leave to amend the Indictment,

**NOTING** that the Amended Indictment was filed by the Prosecutor on 14 January 2004,

**CONSIDERING** that, pursuant to Rule 50 (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”), if the amended indictment includes new charges and the accused has already appeared before a Trial Chamber in accordance with Rule 62, a further appearance shall be held as soon as practicable to enable the accused to enter a plea on the new charges,


**CONSIDERING** that the Amended Indictment includes new charges,

**CONSIDERING** that the initial appearance of the accused Ivica Rajić took place on 27 June 2003,

**PURSUANT** to Rule 50 (B) of the Rules,

**HEREBY ORDER** that a further appearance will be held on Thursday, 29 January 2004 at 15:00 hours in Courtroom I;
