THE APPEALS CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

NOTING that the parties have completed the filing of appeal briefs;

NOTING that the “Decision on Appellants’ Motions to Admit Additional Evidence Pursuant to Rule 115,” issued by the Appeals Chamber on 16 February 2004, ordered that the Witnesses identified in Items 4 and 16 of Confidential Annex D to that decision (“Additional Witnesses”) will be heard by the Appeals Chamber on a date specified by a scheduling order to be issued;

PURSUANT to Rule 114 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;


HEREBY ORDERS THAT:

1. The hearing on appeal shall commence on 23 March 2004 with the hearing of the Additional Witnesses;
2. The final arguments of the parties will be heard at the close of the hearing of the Additional Witnesses and any admitted rebuttal material;
3. The Appellant Zigić shall be responsible for contacting the Additional Witnesses in order to make arrangements for their appearance before the Appeals Chamber on 23 March 2004;
4. The Appellant Zigić shall file any motion seeking protective measures for the Additional Witnesses by 23 February 2004;
5. The Prosecution shall file any motion to adduce rebuttal material by 27 February 2004;
6. The Appellant Zigić shall file any response to a Prosecution motion to adduce rebuttal material by 5 March 2004;
7. The Prosecution shall file any reply thereto by 10 March 2004;

A further scheduling order will be issued in due course to deal with the allocation of time for the hearing on appeal and related matters.
