TRIAL CHAMBER II (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”):

NOTING that the Scheduling Order issued by the Trial Chamber on 22 March 2004 (“Scheduling Order”) reads:

CONSIDERING that from 14 to 18 April 2004 the Trial Chamber, in the presence of the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) and Defence Counsel for the accused Radoslav Brđanin (“Accused”), conducted the on-site visit of a number of locations relevant to the case against the Accused;

CONSIDERING that the reference to “14 to 18 April 2004” is erroneous and should instead read “14 to 18 March 2004”;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;


HEREBY ORDERS that the Scheduling Order be altered to read as set out above.
