CONSIDERING that Radislav Krstić is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending the decision in the appeal in this case;


CONSIDERING that the last appearance of Radislav Krstić in court was at the appeal hearing on 21, 26 and 27 November 2003;

CONSIDERING that Rule 65*bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal requires the convening of a status conference within one hundred and twenty days of the last status conference to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person;

ORDER that a status conference shall be held before me on Thursday, 1 April 2004, at 17:00 hours in Courtroom 2.
