TRIAL CHAMBER II (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”):

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;


HEREBY SCHEDULES the Closing Arguments of the parties from 19 to 22 April 2004.
