TRIAL CHAMBER I ("Trial Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

PURSUANT to Rule 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,



CONFIRMS that 5 April 2004 shall be the date from which for any purposes it shall be recorded that the Accused has been in the custody of the Tribunal.
