I, JOAQUÍN MARTÍN CANIVELL, Judge in Trial Chamber I (“the Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the Tribunal”);

NOTING the decision of 23 May 2003 of the Presiding Judge of the Chamber to appoint me as the Pre-Trial Judge in the case *The Prosecutor vs. Milan Martić* (“the Accused”);

NOTING that the last Status Conference under Rule 65*bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“the Rules”) was held on 22nd January 2004;

NOTING that Rule 65*bis* of the Rules requires the Pre-Trial Judge to organize the exchanges between the parties and to review the status of the case with regular intervals in order to allow the accused an opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including his mental or physical conditions;


PURSUANT to Rules 65*bis* and 65*ter*;
