I, WOLFGANG SCHOMBURG, a Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING that Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) requires “the Appeals Chamber or an Appeals Chamber judge” to “convene a status conference, within one hundred and twenty days of the filing of a notice of appeal and thereafter within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person”,

NOTING the “Order Designating a Pre-Appeal Judge”, issued on 6 October 2003, appointing me as Pre-Appeal Judge in this case,


NOTING that the last status conference in this case was held on 6 May 2004 and the appeals hearings from 17 to 19 May 2004,

CONSIDERING that Dario Kordić and Mario Čerkez are currently in detention in the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending appeal,

PURSUANT to Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules,

HEREBY ORDER that a status conference be held before the Pre-Appeal Judge on 21 July 2004, in Courtroom III, at 9.00 a.m.
