I, Judge Liu Daqun, Presiding Judge at the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

NOTING the Order of the President of the Tribunal of 5 April 2004 assigning this case to Trial Chamber I;

NOTING my Order of 5th April 2004 to designate Judge Alphons Orie as Pre-Trial Judge;

NOTING that the initial appearance of the accused Jadranko Prlić, Bruno Stojić, Slobodan Praljak, Milivoj Petrović, Valentin Ćorić and Berislav Pušić took place on 6 April 2004;

NOTING that Rule 65*bis* of the Rules requires the Pre-Trial Judge to review the status of the case every 120 days and to allow the accused an opportunity to raise issues in relation to his mental or physical conditions;

NOTING the six Requests for provisional release filed by the Accused in this case;¹

NOTING the Prosecutor's Responses to all six Requests for provisional release;²

NOTING the Replies to the Prosecutor's Responses, filed by the Accused Prlić, Ćorić, Pušić and Praljak;

NOTING the two letters filed on 28th June 2004 and 1st July 2004 by the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs to the Tribunal informing the Registry that the Netherlands does not have any objections to the provisional release of the Accused Praljak, Pušić, Petković and Stojić;

NOTING that the present Scheduling Order is issued by me in Judge Orie's absence;

PURSUANT to Rules 54, 62, 65 and 65*bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

HEREBY ORDERS that a Status Conference be held on Monday 19 July 2004 at 14:30 hours in Courtroom III in the presence of the Accused and their Defence Counsels;


ORDERS that a hearing to address the Motions for Provisional Release of the Accused be held in immediate continuation of the Status Conference scheduled for Monday 19 July 2004 at 14:30 hours in Courtroom III;

INVITES the Government of the Republic of Croatia to present, either in writing before Monday, 19 July 2004 or orally by attending the scheduled hearing on that day, its assurance that the Accused, if provisionally released, will appear for trial;

INVITES the Government of the Kingdom of The Netherlands to indicate before Monday, 19 July 2004 whether it has any objections to the provisional release of the Accused Prlić and Čorić.
