**I, FLORENCE NDEPELE MWACHANDE MUMBA**, Pre-Appeal Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

**NOTING** that Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“the Rules”) requires “the Appeals Chamber or an Appeals Chamber Judge” to “convene a status conference, within one hundred and twenty days of the filing of a notice of appeal and thereafter within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person”;

**NOTING** the “Order Designating a Pre-Appeal Judge”, issued on 28 July 2004, appointing me as Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

**CONSIDERING** that Milan Babić is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending the hearing of his appeal;

**PURSUANT** to sub-Rule 65bis(B) and after consulting the parties;

**HEREBY ORDER** that a Status Conference be held before me on 17 December 2004 at 2:30pm.
