
NOTING the Order “Appointing a Trial Chamber for the Purpose of Determining Whether an Indictment Should be Referred to Another Court Under Rule 11bis” (“Order”), filed on 2 November;

NOTING that the Order states that the assigned Trial Chamber is to consider whether the case “should be referred to the authorities of the State Union of Serbia and Montenegro pursuant to Rule 11bis”, and should state that the assigned Trial Chamber is to consider whether the case should be referred to the authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina;

HEREBY replace the sentence “should be referred to the authorities of the State Union of Serbia and Montenegro pursuant to Rule 11bis”, with the sentence “should be referred to the authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina pursuant to Rule 11bis”.
