I, ALPHONS ORIE, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the Decision of Judge Carmel Agius (“the confirming Judge”) to confirm the indictment against Beqë BEQAJ (“the Accused”) and the Warrants of Arrest and Orders for Surrender, all issued *ex parte* and under seal on 29th October 2004;

NOTING the arrest in Priština by UNMIK on 19th October 2004 of the Accused and his subsequent transfer to the custody of the Tribunal on 4th November 2004;

NOTING the President’s confidential Order of 3rd November 2004 to assign the case to Trial Chamber I as of the date of transfer of the Accused to the seat of the Tribunal;

NOTING the Presiding Judge’s Order of 4th November 2004 to designate me as Pre-Trial Judge in the present case;


NOTING that the initial appearance of the accused Beqë BEQAJ could not be held on Friday, 5th November 2004 due to unavailability of Albanian interpretation;
