NOTING the Indictment in the *Prosecutor v Miroslav Bralo*, filed on 3 November 1995;



NOTING that Rule 62 requires the President of the Tribunal forthwith assign the case to a Trial Chamber;

HEREBY ASSIGN, effective on the date upon which the accused is transferred to the seat of the Tribunal, the present case to Trial Chamber I.
