TRIAL CHAMBER I, SECTION A, (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

CONSIDERING that the Trial Chamber has issued some decisions and orders in this case on a confidential basis, for the safety of the witnesses or in the interests of justice,

CONSIDERING FURTHER that the Trial Chamber has ordered that the testimony of certain witnesses be heard in private session, in whole or in part, for the safety of the witness or in the interests of justice,

FINDING that the reasons for issuing certain decisions and orders on a confidential basis, and for one part of testimony to be heard in private session, are no longer applicable,


PURSUANT TO Rule 54, 69, 75 and 79 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal,
