
NOTING the President’s Order of 17 January 2005 reassigning the case *The Prosecutor v. Sefer HALILOVIĆ* (IT-01-48-PT) to Trial Chamber I with immediate effect;

NOTING that a Pre-Trial Conference was held on Monday, 24 January 2005;

**HEREBY ORDER:**

1. the Pre-Trial Conference shall be continued on 27 January 2005 at 13:00 in Courtroom III in the presence of the Accused and his Defence Counsel, pursuant to Rule 73 *bis* (A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”);
2. the trial shall commence on 31 January 2005 at 09:00 in Courtroom III;
3. the trial proceedings shall commence with the Opening Statement of the Prosecution, pursuant to Rule 84 of the Rules; the Defence may not make a “response” to the Opening Statement of the Prosecution, as such a response is not provided for in the Rules;
4. the trial proceedings shall continue with the Opening Statement of the Defence for the Accused, should the Defence elect to make its Opening Statement at this stage of the proceedings, rather than after the conclusion of the Prosecution’s presentation of evidence and before the presentation of evidence for the defence, as permitted in Rule 84 of the Rules;
5. the trial proceedings shall continue with a statement, under the control of the Trial Chamber, by the Accused, should he wish to make a statement, as permitted by Rule 84 *bis* of the Rules;
6. the Prosecution shall commence the presentation of evidence on 1 February 2005, as indicated in Rule 85 of the Rules.
