PURSUANT TO Rule 114 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal;


HEREBY ORDERS that oral arguments in the present appeal be heard on Friday 18 March 2005, commencing at 9:00 a.m., and that: (1) the Appellant shall have up to 30 minutes to make his oral submission; (2) the Prosecution shall have up to 30 minutes in response to the Appellant’s submission; and (3) the Appellant shall have up to 10 minutes to reply to the Prosecution’s response;

DIRECTS the parties to prepare themselves in such a way as not simply to recount what has been set out in their written submissions, but to confine their oral arguments to elaborating on points relevant to this appeal that they wish to bring to the Appeals Chamber’s attention, and

ORDERS the parties to file public redacted versions of the Appellant’s Brief and the Respondent’s Brief by no later than 7 March 2005.
