NOTING the Order of the Vice-President of 18 January 2005 assigning this case of *The Prosecutor v Savo Todović* to Trial Chamber II;


NOTING that the Initial Appearance of Savo Todović was held before me on 19 January 2005;

NOTING that Savo Todović declined to enter a plea at the Initial Appearance;
