THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the

Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

HAVING ISSUED an "Order on Adjournment of Status Conference" on 10 February 2005, in

which the parties were ordered to respond as to whether they consent to adjourning the Status

Conference, scheduled in this case for 23 February 2004, until a subsequent date to be set by the

Trial Chamber, on the basis that there are currently proceedings brought by the Prosecution

pursuant to Rule 11 bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules") in this case, and that

there is a hearing scheduled on this matter for 3 and 4 March 2005,

NOTING that the Prosecution has responded stating that it has no objections to adjournment of

the Status Conference,

NOTING that the Defence for Fuštar has responded stating that it has no objection to

adjournment of the Status Conference,

NOTING that the Defence for Mejakić, Gruban and Knežević have responded jointly stating

that they consent to an adjournment of the Status Conference "for the week in which the hearing

on referral of a case under Rule 11 bis is scheduled", and that should they receive material

sought from the Prosecution in relation to exhumations, they consent to an adjournment "for any

other date the Trial Chamber finds appropriate",

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 65 bis of the Rules.

HEREBY ORDERS that the Status Conference scheduled for 23 February 2005 is adjourned

until a subsequent date to be set by the Trial Chamber.
