NOTING the Indictment in *The Prosecutor v Radivoje Miletic and Milan Gvero*;


NOTING that the Registry has advised that the Accused, Milan Gvero, will be detained and transferred to the seat of the Tribunal pursuant to Rule 62 on 24 February 2005;

NOTING that Rule 62 requires that the President of the Tribunal forthwith assign the case to a Trial Chamber;

HEREBY ASSIGN, effective on the date upon which Milan Gvero is transferred to the seat of the Tribunal, the present case to Trial Chamber II.
