THIS SPECIALLY APPOINTED CHAMBER II (“the Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”):

BEING SEISED OF the Prosecutor’s Request of 21 September 2004 for referral of the present case by a Trial Chamber under Rule 11 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“the Rules”) to the State of Bosnia and Herzegovina, after having given, if it deems necessary, the opportunity to the authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina to be heard on the Request and the conditions for the referral of this case;

NOTING the “Scheduling Order for a Hearing on Referral of a Case under Rule 11*BIS*” of 9 February 2005;

CONSIDERING the need to adapt the scheduling of this hearing;

PURSUANT TO Rule 11 *bis* and 74 of the Rules;

HEREBY SCHEDULES A HEARING on 4 March 2005 at 14.15 in a courtroom designated by the Registry;

INVITES the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to attend the hearing and, should it wish, to present additional oral submissions;


REQUESTS the Registrar to transmit this order immediately to the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
