
CONSIDERING that Miroslav Deronjić is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending the hearing of the appeal;

PURSUANT to Rule 65*bis* (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal which requires the convening of a status conference within one hundred and twenty days of the last status conference to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person;
