**PURSUANT TO** Rule 114 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal;


**HEREBY ORDERS** that oral arguments in the present appeal be re-scheduled to be heard on 14 March 2005 commencing at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom III and **INFORMS** the parties that the timetable of the hearing shall be as follows, subject to adjustments where appropriate:

9:30 a.m. – 9:40 a.m.	Introductory statement by the Presiding Judge;
9:40 a.m. – 10:10 a.m.	Appellant’s submission;
10:10 a.m. – 10:40 a.m.	Prosecution’s response to the Appellant’s submission;
10:40 a.m. – 10:50	Reply to the Prosecution’s response; and
10:50 a.m. – 11:00	Appellant’s personal intervention (optional).

**REMINDS** the parties to prepare themselves in such a way as not simply to recount what has been set out in their written submissions, but to confine their oral arguments to elaborating on points relevant to this appeal that they wish to bring to the Appeals Chamber’s attention, and that public redacted versions of the Appellant’s Brief and the Respondent’s Brief should be filed by no later than 7 March 2005.
