THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

NOTING its "Scheduling Order for Hearing on Defence Requests for Provisional Release", filed

on 2 March 2005 ("Superseded Scheduling Order"), in which the Chamber set the date for an oral

hearing on the Accused's requests for provisional release as Wednesday, 9 March 2005,

CONSIDERING the "Joint Defence Request to Re-Schedule a Hearing on Defence Requests for

Provisional Release", filed on 4 March 2005, in which counsel for the Accused (1) notified the

Chamber that Mr. Zoran Stojković, who is expected to give evidence on the guarantees offered by

the Government of Serbia and Montenegro and the Republic of Serbia in this case, is unable to

attend the hearing on 9 March 2005; and (2) requested that the hearing be postponed to Thursday,

10 March 2005,

PURSUANT to Rules 54 and 65 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International

Tribunal,

HEREBY RESCHEDULES the oral hearing on the Accused's requests for provisional release

from Wednesday, 9 March 2005 to Thursday, 10 March 2005 at 9:00 a.m., and AFFIRMS that all

arrangements for the taking of evidence outlined in the Superseded Scheduling Order remain

unchanged.
