I, AMIN EL MAHDI, Judge in Trial Chamber I (“the Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the Tribunal”);

NOTING the decision of 3 December 2001 of the Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber I to appoint me as the Pre-Trial Judge in the case *The Prosecutor vs. Paško Ljubičić* (“the Accused”);

NOTING that the last Status Conference under Rule 65*bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“the Rules”) was held on 25 November 2004;


NOTING that Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules requires the Pre-Trial Judge to organize the exchanges between the parties, to review the status of the case and to allow the accused an opportunity to raise issues in relation to his mental or physical conditions;

HEREBY ORDERS that a Status Conference be held on Thursday 24 March 2005 at 14h30 in Courtroom III in the presence of the Accused and that the Parties be ready to discuss the status of the case and its final preparation for trial.
