I, Jean-Claude Antonetti, Judge of Trial Chamber II of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the Indictment in the case *The Prosecutor v. Vinko Pandurević*, confirmed by Judge Mumba on 2 November 1998;

NOTING that Vinko Pandurević was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 23 March 2005;

NOTING the Order by the President of the Tribunal of 23 March 2005 assigning the case against Vinko Pandurević (“Accused”) to Trial Chamber II;

PURSUANT TO Rule 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;


