**PURSUANT TO** Rule 62 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;


**HEREBY DESIGNATE** Judge Jean Claude Antonetti, as Judge of Trial Chamber II for the initial appearance of Milorad Trbić.
