**I, WOLFGANG SCHOMBURG**, a Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

**NOTING** the “Order Assigning Judges to a Case Before the Appeals Chamber and Appointing a Pre-Appeal Judge” filed on 28 February 2005 which, *inter alia*, designated me to serve as Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

**NOTING** that Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) requires “[t]he Appeals Chamber or an Appeals Chamber judge” to “convene a status conference, within one hundred and twenty days of the filing of a notice of appeal and thereafter within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person”;


**NOTING** that the “Prosecution’s Notice of Appeal” and the “Defence Notice of Appeal” were both filed on 2 March 2005;
