I, Albin Eser, Judge of Trial Chamber II of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the Indictment in the case *The Prosecutor v. Ljube Bošković and Johan Tarčulovski*, confirmed by Judge Patrick Robinson on 9 March 2005;

NOTING the decision by Judge Patrick Robinson dated 15 March 2005 lifting the confidentiality of the Indictment against Ljube Bošković and Johan Tarčulovski;

NOTING that Johan Tarčulovski (“Accused”) was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 16 March 2005 and his initial appearance pursuant to Rule 62(iii) of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) took place before Judge Carmel Agius on Monday 21 March 2005;

NOTING the thirty days’ time-limit for the Accused to be called upon to enter a plea of guilty or not guilty, as set out in Rule 62 (iii) of the Rules;

NOTING the Order of Judge Carmel Agius issued on 5 April 2005 designating me as the pre-trial Judge in this case;

PURSUANT TO Rules 62 and 65^{ter} of the Rules;


HEREBY SCHEDULE the further initial appearance of Johan Tarčulovski for Monday 18 April 2005 at 14:15 hours in Courtroom III.
