HAVING BEEN DESIGNATED as pre-trial Judge in this matter by virtue of an Order of 23 July 2004,


NOTING the Order of 16 March 2005, scheduling a status conference in this case for Thursday, 14 April 2005, commencing at 3.00 p.m.,
