I, **Liu Daqun**, Judge in the Trial Chamber I (“the Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the Tribunal”);

**NOTING** my decision of 19 November 2004 to appoint me as the Pre-Trial Judge in the case *The Prosecutor v. Miroslav Bralo* (“the Accused”);

**NOTING** that the Accused surrendered himself voluntarily to the SFOR in the village of Medugorje in Bosnia and Herzegovina on 10 November 2004 and was subsequently transferred to the custody of the Tribunal on 12 November 2004;

**NOTING** that the initial appearance of the Accused was held before Judge El Mahdi on 15 November 2004;

**NOTING** that the further appearance of the Accused was held on 14 December 2004;


**NOTING** that Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules requires the Pre-Trial Judge to organize the exchanges between the parties, to review the status of the case and to allow the accused an opportunity to raise issues in relation to his mental or physical conditions;

**PURSUANT** to Rules 54, 65 *bis* and 65 *ter*;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that a Status Conference be held on Thursday 21 April 2005 at 08h00 in Courtroom III in the presence of the Accused and that the Parties be ready to discuss the status of the case.
