THE REFERRAL BENCH of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("the Tribunal");

BEING SEIZED OF the Prosecutor's Motions of 1 November 2004 and 4 November 2004 for

referral of the present case by a Trial Chamber under Rule 11bis of the Rules of Procedure and

Evidence ("the Rules") to the State of Bosnia and Herzegovina, after having given, if it deems

necessary, the opportunity to the authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina to be heard on the Motions

and on the conditions for the referral of this case;
